



CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION TO THE

GIRLGUIDING MIDLANDS 'MAKING A DIFFERENCE' FUND 2019

WHO CAN APPLY

This fund is **NOT** for group applications but for applying on behalf of individual girls.

The Leader of a Unit or an Adult member of Girlguiding Midlands can apply to the fund on behalf of an individual (5 - 18 years old) who they feel would not be able to participate in an event without help and would therefore benefit from financial assistance. A maximum of two applications per member per year.

Suggested ideas for support: -

- Attend a local residential event, activity day or training opportunity
Please note this is not for international opportunities and must be for an event or activity at least twelve weeks in the future as per REN forms. Late applications may not be considered. The fund does not cover applications for uniform or subscriptions.

Full details of the event and anticipated costs must be included with all applications; including how many in unit, district and division will be attending event along with information about contributions from parents, unit, division and other sources.

AMOUNT AVAILABLE

An amount each year will be allocated to the fund and any applications will be treated on an individual basis, the fund will run until utilised in that year.

A sum of up to £100 maximum is applied for with full cost of event also notified.

Applications will be confidential and authorised by members of Girlguiding Midlands' Finance Committee.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION TO THE GIRLGUIDING MIDLANDS 'MAKING A DIFFERENCE' FUND FOR 'ACTIVE' ADULT MEMBERS 2019

WHO CAN APPLY

This fund is **NOT** for group applications but for a Commissioner to apply on behalf of an individual 'active' adult member (over eighteen). This fund is available when all other options in the County and local areas have been addressed. A maximum of two applications per member per year.

A District/Division/Section or County Commissioner from within the 11 counties of Girlguiding Midlands can apply to the fund on behalf of an individual Adult member who they feel would not be able to take a Leadership role in a Unit or local event or attend a Training opportunity appropriate to their role without benefitting from financial assistance.

In order to qualify, their attendance should make a difference to the experience of young people and be given only when the Unit (and/or members) are unable to help fund the member to help them achieve that experience.

Suggested ideas for support:

- Attend a local residential event, activity day or training opportunity
- **Please note this is not for international opportunities and must be for an event or activity at least twelve weeks in the future as per REN forms.**
- **Late applications may not be considered. The fund does not cover applications for uniform or subscriptions.**

Full details of the event and anticipated costs must be included with all applications, including how many in unit, district and division will be attending along with information about contributions from unit, division and other sources.

AMOUNT AVAILABLE

An amount each year will be allocated to the fund and any applications will be treated on an individual basis, the fund will run until utilised in that year.

A sum of up to £100 maximum is applied for with full cost of event also notified. Applications will be confidential and authorised by members of Girlguiding Midlands Finance Committee.
