What is the Four Seasons Camping Challenge?

Camping isn't just for the Summer - experience life under canvas in each season and earn yourself badges. There is a badge for each season - spring (March, April May), summer (June, July, August), autumn (September, October, November) and winter (December, January, February). When you put all four together you make a picture of a tent!

Who can take part?

All members of Girlguiding Midlands this includes Brownies, Guides, members of the Senior Section, adult volunteers and members of the Trefoil Guild.

Does it count if I stay indoors?

No - you must be staying outdoors.

How do I record my camping challenge?

By completing the Four Seasons Camping challenge record card.

Can the challenge be carried between sections?

Who can sign my record card?

For members under 18, the Leader at the residential event can sign to confirm the number of nights at that particular event. For adult volunteers, another adult volunteer can sign.

Can it be backdated?

The challenge can be backdated to the commencement date of 1 March 2012.

How do I order my badge(s)?

Leaders can order badges by downloading and completing a badge order form, then sending it to the Girlguiding Midlands Region Office along with a cheque for payment.
